

Dear Parade Participants,

I would like to take this opportunity to invite you and your group to participate in the 57th annual Geneva Area Grape Jamboree Parades. As in the past, we will again have two large parades. The first will be held on Saturday, September 24, 2022, arriving in the festival area **PROMPTLY** at 1:30p.m., and the second will be on Sunday, September 25, 2022 at 2:00p.m. The judging for both parades will be done by the All American Judges Assoc. Both of the parades are **FORWARD MOTION PARADES**. This means that **NO ONE** can stop their unit to perform **at any time**. Stopping forward motion creates gaps which are not acceptable.

The Grape Jamboree is a family event. All parade entries **MUST BE FAMILY ORIENTED** and acceptable for all age groups. At the sole discretion of the Grape Jamboree Committee, any objectionable parade units may be immediately pulled from the parade and not allowed to participate.

Enclosed you will find your parade application and the parade waiver that must be signed for you to participate in this year's parade. Included is "Entry and Prize Categories list". Please fill out the parade application and make sure you list the category or categories your group is to be judged in. This information will be passed on to the parade judges so they are able to judge your group in the correct category. Also, on the back of the application or on a separate sheet of paper, please give us information you would like the parade announcer to read as your group is passing by the judging stand in the center of town. This is very important for the Announcers. **Please keep this under 30 seconds!**

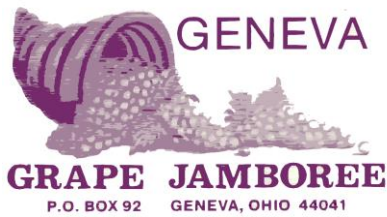
Please mail your application so it reaches us on or before September 10, 2022. Since it takes a great deal of time and planning to line up both parades, please send your application as soon as possible for best positioning in the parade. We will be sending out your parade lineups around September 15, 2022. If you email your application, we will confirm we received it, and then send your lineup confirmation through your email. Any entries that reach us after this date **WILL NOT** be judged for prizes. **Absolute cutoff date is September 16, 2022.**

YOU MAY ENTER IN EITHER THE SATURDAY OR SUNDAY PARADE OR BOTH DAYS. PLEASE BE SURE THAT THE CORRECT CATEGORY NUMBER YOU CHOOSE TO ENTER APPEARS AT THE DESIGNATED SPACE ON YOUR APPLICATION.

The All-American Judges will make the final decisions regarding categories during parade judging.

Baton Groups: Baton with Recorded Music

No. 1 - Junior Division - Average age under 14

No. 2 - Senior Division - Average age 14 and over

Baton with Percussion or Instrumentation or Live Music

No. 3 - Junior Division - Average age under 14

No. 4 - Senior Division - Average age 14 and over

#1 & #3 - 1st Place - Trophy plus \$50, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$30, 3rd Place - \$20, each day.

#2 & #4 - 1st Place - Trophy plus \$50, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$30, 3rd Place - \$20, each day.

Color Guards:

No. 5 - Junior Color Guard - Average age under 14

No. 6 - Senior Color Guard - Average age 14 to 18

No. 7 - Adult Color Guard - Average age over 18

1st Place - Trophy plus \$50, each day

Precision Drill Teams: (Minimum of 12 participants)

No. 8 - Junior Precision Drill Team - Average age under 14

No. 9 - Senior Precision Drill Team - Average age 14 and over

1st Place - Trophy plus \$50, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$30, 3rd Place - \$20, each day.

Classic Cars:

No. 10 - Classic Cars (Cars that are 25 – 49 Years Old)

1st Place - Trophy plus \$50, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$30, 3rd Place - \$20, each day.

Antique Cars:

No. 11 - Antique Cars (Cars that are 50 Years or Older)

1st Place - Trophy plus \$50, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$30, 3rd Place - \$20, each day.

Motorized Precision Units:

No. 12 - Motorized Precision Units (example-groups of cars or motorcycles doing drills)

1st Place - Trophy plus \$75, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$50, 3rd Place - \$25, each day.

Novelty Units: - All units that do not qualify for the above categories.

No. 13A - Small Groups - Less than 10 participants

No. 13B - Large Groups - Over 10 participants

1st Place - Trophy plus \$50, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$30, 3rd Place - \$20, each day.

Floats:

No. 14 - Youth Floats - Average under 14

No. 15 - Non-Commercial Floats

No. 16 - Commercial Floats

1st Place - Trophy plus \$75, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$50, 3rd Place - \$25, each day.

SUNDAY ONLY

Queens Floats:

No. 17 - Queens Floats (Visiting Royalty with Floats)

1st Place - Trophy plus \$75, 2nd Place - Trophy plus \$50, 3rd Place - \$25.

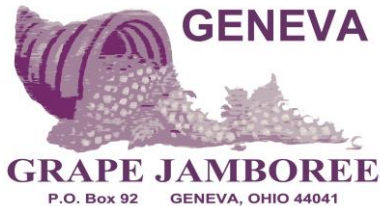

GENEVA GRAPE JAMBOREE PARADE RULES

PLEASE CAREFULLY READ THESE RULES AND REVIEW THEM WITH YOUR GROUP BEFORE THE PARADE SO THAT YOUR ENTRY IS NOT DISQUALIFIED OR PENALIZED AS A RESULT OF A MISUNDERSTANDING.

1. This is a FORWARD MOTION PARADE and any lengthy delays for a performance will mean points deducted or disqualification by the Judges. **Also, no one is allowed to get in or out of a unit once the parade has started.**
2. Please maintain supervision of your participants while in your mustering area until your unit is instructed to move.
3. Do Not Litter or permit participants to disturb private property in the mustering areas.
4. All units must remain in their assigned mustering position unless instructed to move to a different area by a Parade Marshal. This is important for the Announcers and Judges.
5. Space your unit 25 to 40 feet from unit ahead of you and hold that distance throughout the parade route. **POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED BY JUDGES FOR LARGE GAPS BETWEEN UNITS.**
6. **ABSOLUTELY NO THROWING OF CANDY OR ANYTHING DURING PARADE.** Candy, balloons, etc. may be **HANDED** to crowd by individuals walking along the side(s) of the parade. But **NO** items may be tossed from floats or moving vehicles because of the safety factors involved.
7. According to Ohio Revised Code 4511.51 & 4511.99:
Passengers are prohibited from riding in the open bed of a truck with the vehicles tailgate unlatched or open. Also, all van doors must be closed if passengers are riding inside. No riding on roofs, hoods doors, or windows of vehicles. Violators will be IMMEDIATELY removed from the parade!
8. The Parade will be held as scheduled rain or shine.
9. Any unit with animals MUST promptly clean up after them. Any failure will result in removal from the parade and loss of judging.
10. Reviewing Stand with Judges and Announcers will be located on your left in the center of town. Please do not stop at the Reviewing Stand.
11. Awards will be presented after the parade at the Main Stage in the center of town.

GENEVA AREA GRAPE JAMBOREE PARADE WAIVER

The undersigned wishes to participate in the Geneva Area Grape Jamboree, Inc., dba Grape Jamboree, Parade to be held **September 24th & 25th, 2022**. The undersigned acknowledges that it has been notified by the Geneva Area Grape Jamboree, Inc., Parade Committee that it is insured against any and all risks involved with participation in said parade, and agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Geneva Area Grape Jamboree, Inc., and all volunteers and officers, from and against all claims and lawsuits, as a result of being in the parade. The undersigned also agrees to waive any and all claims or rights of action it may have against the Geneva Area Grape Jamboree, Inc., and all volunteers and officers, for any damages incurred as a result of its involvement in said parade.

Waiver/Release for Communicable Diseases Including COVID-19 and its variants.

In consideration of being allowed to participate on behalf of the **Geneva Area Grape Jamboree, Inc.** related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees on behalf of the entire group entering the parade that:

1. Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to MRSA, influenza, and COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist; and,
2. I (we) KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my (our) participation; and,
3. I (we) willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation as regards protection against infectious diseases. If, however, I (we) observe and any unusual or significant hazard during my (our) presence or participation, I (we) will remove myself (ourselves) from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
4. I (we), for myself (ourselves) and on behalf of my (our) heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS the Geneva Area Grape Jamboree, Inc. their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, The City of Geneva, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("RELEASEES"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL ILLNESS, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or damage to person or property, WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF RELEASEES OR OTHERWISE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
