Welcome to the 58th Annual Geneva Grape JAMboree "Something for Everyone"

Approximately 1,500 acres of grapes are grown in the Geneva, Ohio area. The grapes are processed into juice, jam, concentrates, or wine.

Specific growing conditions, which exist only in a narrow band from the Lake Erie shore to ten miles inland, contribute to the success of grape growing in this region.


In the spring, the frozen waters of Lake Erie keep the air in the region colder later into the year. This prevents the vines from budding out early only to be damaged by a late spring frost. Although with the usual spring weather we have had in the last few years a lot of damage has occurred to the grape vines.

In the fall, the now-warm waters of the lake help prevent early fall frosts which may damage the grape crop before it can be harvested. The local grapes, especially the concords, are featured at the annual Geneva Grape JAMboree held the last full weekend of September.

The JAMboree is a celebration of the grape harvest. Visitors may taste grapes, freshly squeezed grape juice, grape pies, wine, and various other grape products. All grandstand entertainment, including the "grape stomping," is free.

There are two giant parades: Saturday, 1:30 p.m., and Sunday, 2 p.m. The contests, art show, craft show, Grape Jamboree winery, and other many interesting exhibits make the JAMboree and entertaining, JAM-packed weekend for the entire family. Geneva is in Northeastern Ohio, 2 miles north of I-90 Exit 218.



pose. I wish I could help every little princess find their voice. I hope that during my rein I have inspired at least one person to know that they can make a difference by starting with a simple "Hello".


